Content

Law development: In May 2016, the final Draft of the Act on Amendments to the Gender Equality Act was tabled at the Croatian Parliament, with a proposal to adopt the Act in urgent procedure.

Key points of analysis: The main objective of the proposed amendment is to align the definition of victimisation from Article 2 of the Gender Equality Act (Official Gazette *Narodne novine* no. 82/08) with the broader definition of victimisation from the Anti-Discrimination Act (Official Gazette *Narodne novine* nos. 85/08 and 112/12). The Draft Act also contains several minor methodological adjustments.
